PEGASO VIÑAS VIEJAS / Cebreros Pegaso Pizarra (2015)

The Pizarra vineyards are usually found on metamorphic soils. This type of soil is found at an altitude above 950 meters, up to 1,200 meters, mainly with an eastern orientation. The wines from here have a different expression, they are always complex, direct and profound.


Native yeasts. 24-30 months in barrels of 500 and 400 liters of French oak from different forests and origins.

Slate soils. On metamorphic rock. Mainly oriented to the east at altitudes above 950 meters.

VINTAGE CHARACTERISTICS

2015 was probably the warmest vintage in the history of Spain. It is precisely in vintages like this one when the old vines show all their singularity and adaptability. Between April and August we had high temperatures and even drought. Thanks to rains at the beginning of September which refreshed the vines and the grapes, production was healthy and generous. We are happy with the results of this challenging vintage.
